Applications are invited from suitable candidates for filling up the purely temporary position of one Semi-skilled labour in the DST- J. C. Bose Research project entitled "Functional characterization of Ubiquitin conjugation pathway genes for delineating its role in Tomato leaf curl disease tolerance in tomato", of Dr. Manoj Prasad, Scientist, NIPGR. The details of the position are as under:

Semi-Skilled Labour (One post): Emoluments based on daily wages rates of Govt. of NCT of Delhi.

Qualification: Candidates with Matriculation and having minimum of 2 years' experience of working in the agricultural field, nursery, greenhouse and laboratory are eligible to apply. Preference will be given to the candidates worked with growing plants for experiments and experience in assisting researchers for plant sample collection/handling in the field, nursery and greenhouse.

The above position is completely on temporary basis and co-terminus with the project. The wages amount for the above position is as per daily wages rates of Govt. of NCT of Delhi. The initial appointment will be for one year or till the tenability of the project whichever is earlier and the same can be curtailed/extended on the basis of assessment of the candidate's performance and discretion of the Competent Authority. NIPGR reserves the right to select the candidate against the above post depending upon the qualification and experience of the candidate. Reservation of posts shall be as per Govt. of India norms. The appointment may be terminated any time by giving one month notice by either side. The applicants will have no claim implicit or explicit for consideration against any regular position of NIPGR.
